- d. A translation of the grade list into English or Croatian, if necessary ^{2,3}
- e. A copy of your CV, written in English using Europass format
- f. Your personal letter of motivation, explaining why you wish to enrol in this program, written in English
- g. Two letters of reference, at least one of which should be from a member of faculty at the institution where you completed your undergraduate course. These should be written in English, and may either be supplied by the applicant or sent to us directly by the referees using the email address above

*If your application is successful, then this form will also be used to apply for recognition of your previous degrees by the University of Rijeka. This is a requirement for enrolment. In this case, we will also require the following from you. **YOU DO NOT NEED TO SEND THESE WITH YOUR INITIAL APPLICATION:***

- h. Copies of the official degree certificate and final grade list/diploma certificate, if not provided previously*
- i. Notary certified translations of your undergraduate degree and grade list/diploma supplement into Croatian if necessary ^{3,4} and if not provided previously*
- j. Official curricula (syllabus) of the undergraduate degree program, with short descriptions of the content of all courses*
- k. If you have changed your name since graduation: A copy of your birth certificate, plus translation if necessary ³*
- l. Proof of your citizenship (or of refugee status) plus translation if necessary ³*
- m. Proof of payment of an administrative fee of 400 HRK (approx. 50 EUR). This can also be deducted from your first tuition fee payment by arrangement.*

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Notes:

- 1) Applications may also be submitted if you have not yet completed your undergraduate degree, but expect to do so by 30th June 2021. In this case, please instead supply a confirmation of your enrolment, and a list of grades for all years of study completed to date.
- 2) For the initial application procedure an unofficial translation will suffice. If you are accepted for the course, then a notary certified translation will be required, see item (i).
- 3) Documents written in English, Croatian, Bosnian or Serbian (Latin alphabet) do not need to be translated.
- 4) A translation into English may be provided instead, if translation services into Croatian from your language are not easily available.
